3. Does the management support the projects and do what it can to pave the way for projects?
4. Do you prepare a stakeholder analysis before beginning a project? Do you find out who has an interest in the project?
5. Do you prepare a risk analysis before beginning a project? Do you discover the potential risks that could affect the project, and do you estimate the probability and consequences of a given risk?
6. Is there usually a good team spirit in your projects? Is there good cooperation and does everybody pull in the same direction – toward the project's goal?
7. Is work on the project given sufficiently high priority in relation to other tasks?
8. Is the right person always chosen as project manager, or is there another employee who is better qualified to take on this demanding job?
